



Size: UK 10/12 (14/16) - US 6/8 (10/12)
EU 36/38 (40/42)

Note: figures in brackets () refer to larger size.

Where only one figure is given this refers to both sizes.

Skill Level: advanced

How much yarn: 12 (14) balls of 50g (50m) of Aurora yarn (100% Wool), shade no. 30252

Needles: A pair of 7.00mm knitting needles

Sewing needle: Yarn needle with rounded point

Other items: Eight stitch-markers

Two stitch-holders

STITCHES

Using needles: K1, P1 rib - Garter stitch (g st)

TENSION

11 sts and 18 rows measure 10cm square over garter stitch with 7.00mm needles. Take time to check tension before starting work: it is essential to work to the stated tensions to achieve success.

INSTRUCTIONS

Back and Fronts: (worked together) starting from Collar, work top down in one piece until to completed yoke. Using 7.00mm needles cast on 34 sts and, for Collar, work 14 rows in garter st (= 8cm). Then increase for raglans as follows: **next row (RS):** K3 (Right Front), place a stitch-marker (= PM), m1

(= pick up horizontal yarn between last st and next st and knit into the back of it - 1 st increased); K3, PM, m1, K2 (right sleeve), PM, m1, K3, PM, m1, K12 (Back), PM, m1, K3, PM, m1, K2 (left sleeve), PM, m1, K3, PM, m1, K3 (Left Front). 8 sts have been increased.

Next row: K to end. Cont to work in g st, inc 1 st, on next and every following alternate row, above each stitch-marker 19 (21) times. There are 194 (210) sts. When work measures 31 (33)cm from beg, corresponding to 56 (60) rows, divide piece as follows: **next row (RS):** K26 (28) for Right Front, place next 45 (49) sts on a stitch-holder for Right Sleeve, K52 (56) for Back, place next 45 (49) sts on another stitch-holder for Left Sleeve, K26 (28) for Left Front. There are 104 (112) sts. Cont to work other 99 (107) rows in garter st [= 56 (60)cm]. Cast off.

Sleeves: for each sleeve, replace on a needle the 45 (49) sts on stitch-holder and cont to work in g st, dec 1 st at each end on every following 5th row 11 times. When Sleeve measures 34 (38)cm, corresponding to 62 (68) rows, cast off rem 23 (27) sts. Sew sleeve seams.

Belt: with 7.00mm needles cast on 10 sts and work 200 (212)cm in K1, P1 rib. Cast off.

Note: wash garment carefully at low temperatures, with a very little fabric softener. Lay the garment to dry on a flat surface, without ever hanging it.
