





**Size:** UK 10 – US 6 – EU 36

**Skill Level:** advanced for dress  
Intermediate for bag

## DRESS

**How much yarn:** 4 balls (each ball 50g and 214m) of Silky yarn (100% Silk) shade no. 8905

**Hook:** A 3.00mm crochet hook

**Sewing needle:** Yarn needle with rounded point

## BAG

**How much yarn:** 4 balls (each ball 50g and 100m) of Nuovo Jaipur yarn (100% Makò Combed Cotton) whose 3 balls shade no. 8881 coral and 1 ball shade no. 6576 cream.

**Hook:** A 3.75mm crochet hook

**Sewing needle:** Yarn needle with rounded point.

**Other items:** 190cm 'sailor' rope; two transparent beads in same shade with right sized hole; fabric glue.

## STITCHES

**Using hook:** chain (ch) – Slip stitch (ss)

Double crochet (dc) – Half treble (htr) – Treble (tr)

**SHELL STITCH (ONLY FOR DRESS):** (work over a multiple of 9 sts.) **Row 1:** ch3 (= first tr), 1 tr into same st or ch at base of ch3, 1 tr into next st or ch, \* ch1, miss next st or ch, 1 tr into each of next 2 sts or ch, ch1, miss next st or ch, 1 tr into each of next 5 sts or ch; rep from \* to last 7 sts; ch1, miss next st or ch, 1 tr into each of next 2 sts or ch, ch1, miss next st or ch, 1 tr into each of next 3 sts or ch; turn. **Row 2:** ch5 (ch3= first tr and ch2= sp), 1 dc into next ch1-sp, \* ch3, miss 2 tr, 1 dc into next ch1-sp, ch2, (1 tr, ch1 and 1 tr) into centre tr of next group, ch2, 1 dc into next ch1-sp; rep from \* ending with ch3, miss 2 tr, 1 dc into next ch1-sp, ch2 and 1 tr into 3rd of first ch3 of 1st row. Turn. **Row 3:** ch1, 1 dc into 1st tr, \* ch3, 5 tr into next ch3-space, ch3, 1 dc into next ch1-sp; rep from \* ending with last dc into 3rd ch at beg of previous row. Turn. **Row 4:** ch1, 1 dc into first dc, ch1, 1 dc into next ch3-sp, \* ch2, (1 tr, ch1 and 1 tr) into centre tr of next group, ch2, 1 dc into next ch3-sp, ch3, 1 dc into next ch3-sp; rep from \* ending with ch2, (1 tr, ch1 and 1 tr) into centre tr of next group, ch2, 1 dc into next ch3-sp, ch1, 1 dc into last st. Turn. **Row 5:** ch3 (= first tr), 2 tr into 1st st, ch3, \* 1 dc into next ch1-sp, ch3, 5 tr into next ch3-space, ch3; rep from \* ending with 1 dc into next ch1-sp, ch3 and 3 tr into last dc. Turn. **Row 6:** ch3 (= first tr), ch2, 1 dc into next ch3-sp, \* ch3, 1 dc into next ch3-sp, ch2, (1 tr, ch1 and 1 tr) into centre tr of next group, ch2, 1 dc into next ch3-sp; rep from \*

ending with ch3, 1 dc into next ch3-sp, ch2 and 1 tr into 3rd of first ch3 at beg of previous row. Turn. Rep rows 3–6 throughout.

**SQUARE MOTIF (ONLY FOR BAG):** with cream yarn make a magic ring. Into this ring work: **round 1:** with cream yarn \* 4 tr (Note: ch3 corresponds to first tr on each round), ch3; rep from \* twice more, 4 tr, ch1 and 1 htr into 3rd of first ch3. Pull yarn to close magic ring.

**Round 2:** with coral yarn work 2 tr into space created by last htr; 1 tr between 1st and 2nd tr, 1 tr between 2nd and 3rd tr, 1 tr between 3rd and 4th tr (= there are 3 tr), \* (2 tr, ch5 and 2 tr) into next ch3-sp; 1 tr between 1st and 2nd tr, 1 tr between 2nd and 3rd tr, 1 tr between 3rd and 4th tr; rep from \* twice more, 2 tr into space created by last htr of previous round, ch 1, end with 1 htr into 3rd of first ch3. **Round 3:** with cream yarn work 2 tr into space created by last htr; 1 tr between next tr and following tr, (1 tr between last tr and next tr) 5 times (= there are 6 tr), \* (2 tr, ch5 and 2 tr) into next ch3-sp; 1 tr between next tr and following tr, (1 tr between last tr and next tr) 5 times (= there are 6 tr); rep from \* twice more, 2 tr into space created by last htr of previous round, ch 1, end with 1 htr into 3rd of first ch3. **Round 4:** with coral yarn work 2 tr into space created by last htr; 1 tr between next tr and following tr, (1 tr between last tr and next tr) 8 times (= there are 9 tr), \* (2 tr, ch5 and 2 tr) into next ch3-sp, 1 tr between next tr and following tr, (1 tr between last tr and next tr) 8 times (= there are 9 tr); rep from \* twice more, 2 tr into space created by last htr of previous round, ch 1, end with 1 htr into 3rd of first ch3. **Round 5:** with cream yarn work 2 tr into space created by last htr; 1 tr between next tr and following tr, (1 tr between last tr and next tr) 11 times (= there are 12 tr), \* (2 tr, ch5 and 2 tr) into next ch3-sp, 1 tr between next tr and following tr, (1 tr between last tr and next tr) 11 times (= there are 12 tr); rep from \* twice more, 2 tr into space created by last htr of previous round, ch 1, end with 1 htr into 3rd of first ch3. **Round 6:** with coral yarn work 1 dc into each st of previous round and (2 dc, ch3 and 2 dc) in each ch5-space. End with a ss into 3rd of first ch3. Fasten off.

## TENSIONS

**DRESS:** 26 sts and 16 rows measure 10cm square over Shell stitch with 3.00mm hook.

**BAG:** Each square Motif measures approx 10cm square with 3.75mm hook. Take time to check tensions before starting work: it is essential to work to the stated tensions to achieve success.

## INSTRUCTIONS DRESS

**Back:** with 3.00mm hook ch108 and work in Shell stitch, to have 12 groups of trebles. Dec 1 stitch at each side on 48th, 52nd, 56th, 60th, 64th, 66th, 68th, 70th and 72nd rows (= a whole motif decreased), work 8cm without decreasing, then inc 1 st at each side on next and every alternate row 4 times. (There are 9 groups of trebles plus 1 half Motif at each side). When work measures approx 64cm from beg, end with a 5th row of Shell stitch and work a row of arches as follows: work a ch-3 arches over dc and ch-5 arches over tr, working dc between arches. Then work a row of trebles, working 1 tr into each st or ch to have at end a multiple of 3 plus 1 (= 103 sts). **Next row (mesh row):** 1 tr, \* ch2, miss 2 sts, 1 tr into next st; rep from \* to end. There are 34 squares. Then work a row of trebles, working 1 tr into each st and 2 tr in each ch2-sp. At end, fasten off.

**Front:** ch117 (= there are 13 groups of tr), work as Back and decrease in the same manner. Increase as follows: 1 st at each side every alternate row 9 times (there are 13 groups of tr). When work measures approx 64cm from beg, end with a 5th row of Shell stitch and work a row of arches, then a row of trebles, working 1 tr into each st or ch - and missing any sts evenly - to have at end 97 sts. **Next row (mesh row):** 1 tr, \* ch2, miss 2 sts, 1 tr into next st; rep from \* to end. There are 32 squares. Then work a row of trebles, working 1 tr into each st and 2 tr in each ch2-sp. Continue to work with a row of arches, as follows: \* 1 dc, ch5, miss 4 sts; rep from \* ending with 2 dc. There are 19 arches. Turn and work in Shell stitch, working trebles of 1st row into ch-spaces, starting with a 5tr-group. From 2nd row, dec gradually at each side 2 groups of trebles, during 26 rows. At the same time, when first 8 rows have been worked, divide Front in half and work Cups separately, decreasing also on neck side 2 Motifs gradually during rem rows. At end, work 3 rows of trebles, then fasten off.

**Shoulder straps (make 2):** for each strap, make a chain approx 30cm long, 1 dc into 2nd ch from hook and 1 dc into each of next ch. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Sew side seams, from bottom up to Back last tr row. Finish Back upper edge and Front Cups working a round in Shell stitch as follows: \* 1 dc, ch1, miss 2 sts/ch or 1 tr, into next st work 2 tr, ch1, miss 2 sts; rep from \* ending with a dc. Fasten off. Sew a Shoulder strap on tip of each Cup and, to correspond, on Back upper edge.

## INSTRUCTIONS BAG

Work 17 Square Motifs. From 2nd Motif, following Template arrangement, join Motifs together across last round, inserting hook into both thicknesses (= a stitch from each motif, in correspondence). At end, fold piece and sew side seams. Across bag upper side (= opening side), into each ch-space of Motifs, pass a 95cm length of rope through, close it round with a noose knot (this way you get a double handle) and insert a bead on each end of the rope. Secure the beads with fabric glue.
