







Size: UK 10 - US 6 - EU 36 - Skill Level: advanced

How much yarn: 8 balls (each ball 50g and 200m) of Vip yarn (80% Merino Extrafine Wool, 20% Cashmere - Shrinkproof) shade no. 9360 lilac Needles: Pair of 3.00mm knitting needles A Double-pointed (Dp) needle Sewing needle: Yarn needle with rounded point

STITCHES

Using needles: tubular stitch (for casting on and casting off) - Stocking stitch (st st) - K1, P1 rib Reverse stocking stitch (rev st st) - K2 P2 rib. CABLE: (worked on 6 sts) **Rows 1- 18:** work in stocking stitch. **Row 19:** 6 Left Crossed stitches (= place next 3 sts onto Dp needle, on frontside, K next 3 sts, K3 from Dp needle). **Row 20:** P6. **Rows 21- 24:** work in stocking stitch. Rep Rows 1-24 throughout.

TENSION (after work has been steamed)

31 sts and 36 rows measure 10cm square over reverse stocking stitch with 3.00 mm needles. Take time to check tension before starting work: it is essential to work to the stated tension to achieve success.

INSTRUCTIONS

Back: start from skirt. With 3.00 mm needles cast on 220 sts and, for border, work 4 rows in tubular st and 9cm K2, P2 rib, decreasing 40 sts evenly across last row: there are 180 sts. Cont to work as follows: 22 sts in rev st st, (6 sts Cable, 20 sts in rev st st) 6 times, 2 sts in rev st st. Cont to work, decreasing 1 st at each end on next and every following 18th row 4 times, then every 10th row twice and, AT THE SAME TIME, dec 1 st at either side of 6 cables on next and every following 26th row 3 times, then on following 14th row once: 120 sts remain. When work measures 29cm from border, corresponding to 104 rows, work 6cm K1,P1 for waistedge, decreasing 6 sts evenly across first row: 114 sts remain. Cont to work Bodice in rev st st, inc 1 st at each end on next and every following 6th row 9 times: there are 132 sts. When Bodice measures 15cm, corresponding to 54 rows, shape armholes: cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Then dec 1 st at each end on next and every alternate row 5 times. When armhole measures 18cm, corresponding to 66 rows, shape shoulders: cast off 7 sts at beg of next 2 rows and 8 sts at beg of following 6 rows. Then cast off rem 56 sts.

Front: work as Back until to end of rib waistedge: there are 114 sts. Then cont to work Bodice as follows: 27 sts in rev st st, 6 sts Cable starting from 13th row of this Motif, 13 sts in rev st st, 4 sts in st st, 14 sts in rev st st, 4 sts in st st, 13 sts in rev st st, 6 sts Cable, 27 sts in rev st st. Cont to work, inc 1 st at each end

on next and every following 6th row 9 times: there are 132 sts. When Bodice measures 15cm, corresponding to 54 rows, shape armholes: cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Then dec 1 st at each end on next and every alternate row 5 times. AT THE SAME TIME, in correspondence with 5th crossing of first and last cable, work as follows: Ist Cable: place next 3 sts onto Dp needle, on frontside, K next 3 sts, K1 and K1 tbl into same st (= 1 st increased) and K2 from Dp needle: there are 4 sts. Henceforth, work cable sts separately. Work first 3 sts, now become 4 sts, as 4 Right Crossed stitches (= place next st onto Dp needle, on backside, K next 3 sts, P1 from Dp needle). As shown in picture, move the 3 sts of this cable diagonally to the right throughout the work, crossing the 4 sts every alternate row. When there are 18 sts in rev st st between the two cable parts, work 4 Right Crossed sts with K1 instead of P1 from Dp needle, until to have K4. Work these 4 sts in st st creating a vertical stripe throughout (as shown in picture). Then cont to work the 4 Right Crossed stitches with P1 from Dp needle, as given before. Work in the same manner, but in mirrored shape, the sts of last Cable, reversing crossings and moving the 3 cable sts diagonally to the left (= place next 3 sts onto Dp needle, on frontside, purl next st, K3 from Dp needle). When armhole measures 10cm, shape neck: cast off centre 20 sts, join another ball of yarn and work separately each side, casting off on neck-edge every alternate row: 2 sts 6 times and 3 sts twice. When armhole measures 18cm shape shoulders as Back.

Sleeves: with 3.00 mm needles cast on 100 sts and, for cuff, work 4 rows in tubular st and 7cm K2, P2 rib, decreasing 22 sts evenly across last row: there are 78 sts. Cont to work in rev stocking st, increasing 1 st at each end on next and every alternate row 9 times , then every following 4th row 9 times. There are 114 sts. When work measures 17cm (corresponding to 62 rows) from cuff, shape top: cast off 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Then dec 1 st at each end every row 43 times. When top shaping measures 12cm, cast off rem 20 sts.

FINISHING

Sew a shoulder seam. **Border:** with 3.00 mm needles and RS of work facing, pick up 160 sts around back-and-front neck-edge and work 8 rows K1, P1 and 4 rows in tubular st. Cast off, grafting sts in darning st with yarn needle. Sew border and other shoulder seam. Set in sleeves. Sew side and sleeve seams.

Note: wash garment carefully at low temperatures, with a very little fabric softener. Lay the garment to dry on a flat surface, without ever hanging it.
