



Neck scarf

Skill Level: easy - **Measurements:** approx 12cm width approx 110cm length

How much yarn: 1 ball (50g and 200m) of Vip yarn (80% Extrafine MerinoWool, 20% Cashmere; Shrinkproof) shade no. 10011

Needles: A pair of 3.75mm knitting needles

Sewing needle: Yarn needle with rounded point

STITCHES

Using needles: tubular st - Garter stitch (g st).

TENSION (after work has been steamed)

24 sts and 42 rows measure 10cm square over garter st with 3.75mm needles. Take time to check tension before starting work: it is essential to work to the stated tension to achieve success.

INSTRUCTIONS

With 3.75 mm needles cast on 7 sts and work as follows: 3 sts in tubular st, 1 st in garter st and 3 sts in tubular st. Inside first 3 sts, inc 1 st (to increase, make 1 st as follows: pick up horizontal yarn between last st and next st and knit into the back of it) on next and every following 6th row 24 times. There are 31 sts. Now the work is 34cm long from beg. Cont to work straight 42 cm more, then, inside the 3 tubular sts, on RH (right hand) side dec 1 st on next and every following 6th row 24 times. When work measures 110cm, cast off rem 7 sts.

Note: wash garment carefully at low temperatures, with a very little fabric softener. Lay the garment to dry on a flat surface, without ever hanging it.
