Hat...

Skill Level: intermediate

How much yarn: 3 balls (each ball 50g and 125m) of Milo yarn (100% cotton), shade no. 9538

Hook: A 3.00mm crochet hook

Sewing needle: Yarn needle with rounded point

Other items: Stitch-marker

STITCHES

Using Hook: Chain (ch) – Slip stitch (ss)

Double crochet (dc) – Half treble (htr) – Treble (tr)

INSTRUCTIONS

Make a magic round and, into this round, work as follows:

1st round: ch1, * 1 htr, ch1; rep from * 6 times, end with a ss into first st; pull yarn to close round. **2nd round:** ch1, work in W stitch [= insert hook under next ch, draw a loop, insert hook at centre of next st and draw a loop (there are 3 loops on hook), (yarn on hook and pull through two loops on hook) twice, ch1, insert hook into same place (= centre) of previous st, draw 1 loop, insert hook under next ch, draw a loop, (yarn on hook and pull through two loops on hook) twice, ch1 – frame QR code or see pictures from 1 to 5 above] all around (there are 12 sts).

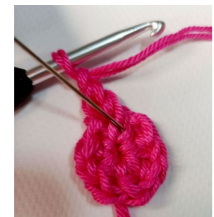

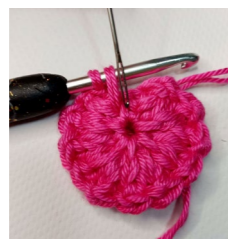


At end of last rep, in each round, omit last ch and work THE LAST STITCH as shown in pictures 1-2 above (i.e. insert hook at centre of next stitch and under ch at round beg, pull yarn through two loops on hook, then pull yarn through last two loops on hook). With 1 W stitch increase 1 stitch.

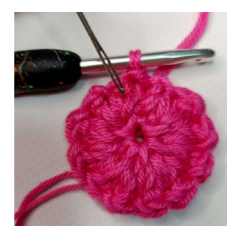


LAST STITCH OF THE ROUND

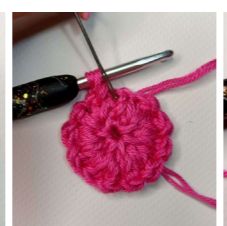
3rd round: (see **ROUND BEG** pictures 1-3 above) ch1, work in W st all round (= 24 sts).

4th and 5th rounds: ch1, work in V stitch [= (insert hook at centre of next st and draw a loop) twice, miss next ch (there are 3 loops on hook) pull yarn through two loops on hook, then pull yarn through last two loops on hook; ch1 – frame QR code and see picture 1 above] all round (= 24 sts).

V STITCH

6th round: ch1, work in W st all around (= 48 sts).

7th, 8th and 9th rounds: ch1, work in V st all around (= 48 sts). **10th round:** ch1, [3 sts in V sts (= 3 sts without ch), 1 st in W st (= ch1, 1 st and ch1)] 12 times (= 60 sts).

11th round: ch1, work in V st all around (= 60 sts).

12th round: ch1, 2 sts in V st, 1 st in W st, (4 sts in V st, 1 st in W st) 11 times, 2 sts in V st (= 72 sts).

13th round: ch1, work in V st all around (= 72 sts).

14th round: ch1, (5 sts in V st, 1 st in W st) 12 times (= 84 sts). From **15th to 26th round:** ch1, place 1 stitch-marker into 1st st of first V stitch to indicate rounds without incs; work in V st all around (= 84 sts).

27th round: ch1, 3 sts in V st, 1 st in W st, (6 sts in V st, 1 st in W st) 11 times, 3 sts in V st (= 96 sts).

28th round: ch1, work in V st all around (= 96 sts).

29th round: ch1, (7 sts in V st, 1 st in W st) 12 times (= 108 sts). From **30th to 33rd round:** ch1, work in V st all around (= 108 sts).

34th round: ch1, (11 sts in V st, 1 st in W st) 9 times (= 117 sts). From **35th to 37th round:** ch1, work in V st all around (= 117 sts).

38th round: ch1, * 1 ss into next st of V st, 1 htr into next ch; rep from * all around. Fasten off.

... & bag

Skill Level: intermediate

Measurements:

Each panel 30cm large and 28cm high

Gusset 15cm wide – Each handle cm 40 long

How much yarn: 5 balls (each ball 50g and 125m) of Milo yarn (100% cotton), shade no. 9519 turquoise and 1 ball shade no. 9538 (printed)

Hook: A 3.00mm crochet hook

Sewing needle: Yarn needle with rounded point

Other items: Lining fabric.

Cord for handles approx 2.5cm in diameter

STITCHES

Using Hook: Chain (ch) – Slip stitch (ss)

Double crochet (dc) – Half treble (htr) – Treble (tr)

Double treble (dtr) – Quadruple treble (qdtr)

PRAWN STITCH: This is dc worked from left to right.

Start at the left-hand end of the row you are working, insert the hook in the first st to the right and complete a dc stitch. Repeat in the next st to the right and continue to the end of the row.

INSTRUCTIONS

Front Panel: with turquoise yarn ch8, join in a ring with a ss into first ch. Into this ring work as follows:

1st round: 16 dc, end with a ss into first dc. **2nd round:** ch2, 2 tr joined together with previous ch2, * ch5, miss 1 st, tr3tog (= 3 tr joined together) into next st; rep from * 6 more times,

ch5, 1 ss at top of first group. **3rd round:** ss to next ch5-space, 1 dc into same sp, * ch7, 1 dc into next sp; rep from * 7 more times, ending with a ss into first dc.

4th round: in each ch7-sp of previous round work a shell (= 1 dc, 1 htr, 1 tr, 6 dtr, 1 tr, 1 htr, 1 dc), but omit last dc at end of last rep; end with a ss into first dc. Fasten off.

5th round: join yarn with a ss into 2nd dtr of next shell, 1 dc into same st, * ch6, miss 2 dtr, 1 dc into next dtr, ch8, dtr4tog (= 4 dtr joined together) into 3rd dtr of next shell, ch9, dtr4tog into next dtr (=coin), ch8, 1 dc into 2nd dtr of next shell; rep from * 3 more times omitting last dc, end with a ss into first dc.

6th round: join yarn with a ss into 6th ch of ch9-coin space just worked, 1 dc into same place, * ch7, 1 dc at top of 2nd dtr4tog-group, ch7, 1 dc into 5th ch of next 8 ch, ch7, 1 dc at centre of next ch6-sp, ch7, 1 dc into 4th ch of next 8 ch, ch 7, 1 dc at top of first dtr4tog-group, ch7, 1 dc into 4th ch of next ch9-coin space **, ch11, miss 1 ch, 1 dc in next ch; rep from * all round but end last rep until to **, ch5, miss 1 ch, 1 qdtr into first dc.

7th round: ch3 (= 1st tr), 2 tr around qdtr of previous round, ch2, * (3 tr into next ch7-sp, ch2) 6 times, 3 tr, ch5 and 3 tr into ch11-coin space, ch2; rep from * all round but, into last ch11-coin space work 3 tr, ch5 and 1 ss into 3rd of first ch3. Fasten off.

8th round: join yarn with a ss into 3rd ch of ch5-coin space just worked, ch3 (= 1st tr), 3 tr around next ch-space, * (ch1, 4 tr into next ch2-sp) 7 times, ch1,

(4 tr, ch5 and 4 tr) into next ch5-coin space; rep from * all round ending with ch1, 4 tr into next ch5-coin space, ch5 and 1 ss into 3rd of first ch3.

9th round: work 3 tr over each 4tr-group of previous round (= miss 1 tr and work 1 tr into each of next 3 tr), 1 tr into each ch1-sp. (2 tr, ch3 and 2 tr) into each ch5-coin space; end this round and next rounds with a ss into first st.

10th round: 1 tr, * ch1, miss 1 st, 1 tr into next st; rep from * all round working (2 tr, ch3 and 2 tr) into each ch3-coin space; end with ch 1: there will be a filet square round.

11th round: work 1 tr into each st and ch of previous round, (2 tr, ch3 and 2 tr) into each ch3-coin space. Rep 10th round (filet squares) and 11th round (trebles) 3 more times. Then, cont across only a side (gusset) working a filet square row, as 10th round, a half treble row and a dc row, working 1 st into each st and ch of previous row. Rep last 3 rows 5 times. Fasten off. Work another gusset as previous on opposite side.

Back Panel: work as Front Panel.

Bag Bottom: ch75, 1 tr into 5th ch from hook, 1 tr into each ch to end. Work 9 more tr rows, rotate work and continue to work on opposite side of starting ch other 10 tr rows. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Join Panels, sewing first each side gusset, then bottom. With printed yarn and hook, work a round of dc and a round of prawn st around bag opening. Fasten off.

Handles: (make 2) for each handle, with printed yarn and hook ch121; work 1 dc into 2nd ch from hook, 1 dc into each ch to end, 1 ch, turn and work 13 more rows dc, at end do not fasten off. Leaving free first and last 4cm, insert cord cut to size and work a row of dc along opposite side of first row to create a tubular handle. Fasten off. Sew lining fabric inside bag and handle ends. Sew handles to Front and Back Panels, as shown in picture. With printed yarn make a tassel and join it to a bag handle, as shown in picture.

Lace mesh shopper

Skill Level: intermediate

How much yarn: 2 balls (each ball 50g and 335m) of Sicilia yarn (100% Polyamide), shade no. 30734 lilac

Hook: A 4.00mm crochet hook

Sewing needle: Yarn needle with rounded point

Other items: cotton cord

STITCHES

Using Hook: Chain (ch) – Slip stitch (ss)

Double crochet (dc) – Half treble (htr)

Treble (tr) – Double treble (Dtr)

PRAWN STITCH: This is dc worked from left to right. Start at the left-hand end of the row you are working, insert the hook in the first st to the right and complete a dc stitch. Repeat in the next st to the right and continue to the end of the row.

INSTRUCTIONS

Bag bottom: work with Sicilia yarn and cotton cord held together to get more strength. Ch39 (approx 13cm) and, starting into 2nd ch from hook, work:

1st round: 1 dc into each of next 37 ch, 5 dc into last ch, rotate work and cont on opposite side of starting ch, working 1 dc into each of next 36 sts and 4 dc into last st. End with a ss into first st. There are 82 sts. Cont to work **8 rounds** of dc and create an oval shape, working 5 dc into the central st of 5 dc on both sides every round, until central length is approx 25cm (i.e. 146 sts). Now continue to work only with Sicilia yarn. Work **7 rounds** of trebles, increasing 3 sts across last round. There are 149 sts. Then work **2 rounds** of dc.

Bag height: cont to work in filet (= lace mesh) pattern.

1st round: ch2 (= 1st half treble), ch1, * miss 1 st, 1 htr into next st, ch1; rep from * all round (there are 74 squares) ending with a ss into 2nd of first ch2. **2nd round:** ch2 (= 1st htr), ch1, * 1 htr into next htr, ch1; rep from * all round ending with a ss into 2nd of first ch2. Work other **2 rounds**, working trebles instead of half trebles, then work **1 round** working double trebles, **5 rounds** working trebles, **3 rounds** working double trebles and **5 rounds** working half trebles. AT THE SAME TIME, while working these rounds, inc **filet squares** in the following rounds:

5th round: 22 filet squares, 1 inc [= 1 st, ch1 and 1 st into same st of previous round], (3 squares, 1 inc) twice, 5 squares, 1 inc, 2 squares, 1 inc, 3 squares, 1 inc, 21 squares, 1 inc, (3 squares, 1 inc) twice, 7 squares, (1 inc) twice, ch1 rep from * all round ending with a ss into top of first st.

10th round: (11 filet squares, 1 inc) 4 times, 12 squares, 1 inc, (11 filet squares, 1 inc) twice, 7 filet squares, end with a ss into top of first st. There are 92 filet squares.

12th round: (36 filet squares, 1 inc) twice, 20 filet squares, end with a ss into top of first st. There are 94 filet squares.

13th round: (12 filet squares, 1 inc) twice, 11 squares, 1 inc,

(12 filet squares, 1 inc) 3 times, 11 squares, 1 inc, 12 filet squares, end with a ss into top of first st. There are 101 filet squares. When **18 rounds in filet patt** (= approx 22cm height from bottom) have been crocheted, work last round in prawn st into each st or ch of previous round. At end, fasten off.

Bag handles: (make 2 alike) for each handle, with 4.00mm crochet hook and Sicilia yarn, work a row of dc around approx 55cm cotton cord, working more sts at beg and at end of cord to cover it thickly. Fasten off.

Trimmings: (make 4 alike) for each handle trimming, with 4.00mm crochet hook and Sicilia yarn make a magic ring. Into ring work: ch1, then for **1st round:** 8 htr (ch1 = first htr), end with a ss into first st. Pull yarn to close ring. **2nd round:** 2 htr in each st of previous round (= 16 sts), end with a ss into first st. Fasten off.

FINISHING

On RS of work, sew ends of each handle, as shown in picture, on frontside and on backside of bag. Leave approx 13cm distance between ends. Sew a trimming over each end.

Tote bag

Skill Level: intermediate

How much yarn: 4 balls (each ball 50g and 163m) of Fresh yarn (100% Flax), shade no. 9508

Hook: A 4.00mm crochet hook

Sewing needle: Yarn needle with rounded point

Other items: 4 stitch-markers. 6 plastic rings 4cm in diameter

STITCHES

Using Hook: Chain (ch) – Slip stitch (ss)

Double crochet (dc) – Half treble (htr) – Treble (tr)

1 RHTRB (= Ridge half treble back): work 1 htr inserting hook into back loop only of previous row)

2 CROSSED TREBLES (CR2TR): miss 1 stitch, work 1 tr into next stitch, then work 1 tr into stitch just missed, inserting hook behind the previous treble.

INSTRUCTIONS

Note: work with 2 strands of yarn held together.

Bottom: ch40, **1st round:** 2 htr into 3rd ch from hook, 1 htr into each of next 36 ch, 6 htr into last ch and cont to work on opposite side of starting ch as follows: 1 htr into each of next 36 sts, 3 htr into beg st, end with a ss into top of first st (there are 84 sts). **2nd round:** ch2 (corresponding to first htr) and, working this round in RhtrB, work 1 htr into same st, inc 1 st (= 2 htr into same st), inc 1 st, 1 htr into each of next 36 sts, (inc 1 st) 6 times, 1 htr into each of next 36 sts, (inc 1 st) 3 times, end with a ss into first st (there are 96 sts). **3rd round:** ch2, inc 1 st, (1 htr into next st, inc 1 st) twice, 1 htr into each of next 36 sts, (1 htr into next st, inc 1 st) 6 times, 1 htr into each of next 36 sts, (1 htr into next st, inc 1 st) 3 times, end with a ss into first st (there are 108 sts). **4th round:** ch2, 1 htr into each of next sts. **5th round:** ch2, 1 in RhtrB into each of next sts.

Bag Height: **1st round:** ch4, * Cr2tr; rep from * all round, ending with a ss into 3rd of first 4 ch. Turn. **2nd round:** 1 dc into same st as previous, ch2, miss 1 st, * 1 dc into next st, ch2, miss 1 st; rep from * all round ending with a ss into first dc; turn. **3rd round:** 2 htr into each ch-2 sp of previous round, starting with ch2= first htr; end with a ss into 2nd of first ch2. There are 108 htr. Turn. Rep from 1st to 3rd round 7 more times, then rep 1st round once more. **26th and 27th rounds:** ch2 (= first htr), work 1 htr into each of next sts, end with a ss into 2nd of first ch2. Fasten off. Cut yarn, leaving a long end. **28th round:** starting from last st, count 23 sts and place a stitch-marker (PM), rep as given on opposite side, using another stitch-marker; then work in the same manner on other bag side; there are 2 stitch-markers on each bag side. Join yarn to PM stitch on a side, ch1 and 1 htr into same st, 1 htr into each st until to next PM st, remove stitch-marker and work last htr, ch1, turn and work 1 htr into first st, 1 htr into each st to end. Fasten off. Rep on other bag side.

Handles: join yarn to last stitch of last row and work as follows: **1st row:** ch3, (Cr2tr) twice, 1 tr, turn. From **2nd to 10th row:** ch3, (Cr2tr) twice, 1 tr, turn. At end of last row, fasten off and cut yarn, leaving a long end. Work other 3 handles in the same manner.

Rings: make 6 (3 rings for each handle) with crochet hook and double yarn, work a round of dc into each ring, to cover it completely. Sew the rings together, to form 2 stripes of 3 rings each. Join each stripe between the two parts of same handle, as shown in picture.

FINISHING

If you prefer, complete bag inserting fabric lining in same or in contrasting colour.
